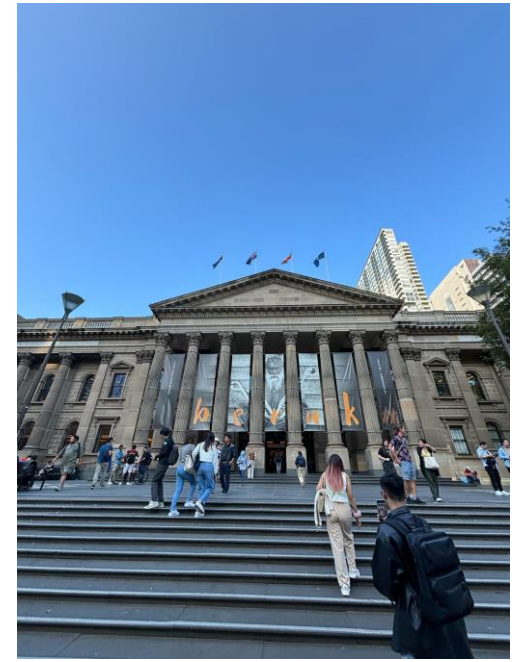

Body 1 Firstly, zoos provide a healthier environment for animals than in the wild. One reason for this is that the animals in zoos receive **veterinary** care. If an animal is weak or gets a disease in the wild, they may die, **whereas** in the zoo, if they get a serious disease, they can receive medicine to make them well again. **Moreover**, animals in the zoo receive a healthy, balanced diet. In the wild, as animals' habitats are being destroyed by humans, they might not be able to find enough food on their own and particular **species** are becoming endangered.

Body 2 **Secondly**, zoos educate people about animals. **Most** children love animals and learn about them at school. Zoos provide a place where children can experience the animals first hand, rather than just seeing pictures of them in books, which leads to a better understanding. **In addition**, zoos teach the public about the dangers to animals and ways to help them. **For instance**, endangered species, **such as** the Indonesian **orangutan**, are kept in zoos. There are signs at the zoo that tell us what factors are harming the species. As a result of the knowledge that the orangutan's **habitat** is being destroyed to make palm oil plantations, many people have stopped using products containing this oil.
