Aboriginal flag

- Black → Represent Aboriginal
- Yellow → Represent the sun that is the giver and protector of life
- Red → Used for ritual ocher. Represent the land relationship with Aboriginal mental



Aboriginal Australia

- Aboriginal people have lived in Australia long before the continent was discovered by Europeans.
- Already living on the continent more than 40,000 years ago, they are now minority, comprising only a few percent of the population.
- They have no written language, so there are no records of their past, but instead they have dances, songs, and folk tales to tell.

Australian Art

- Melbourne is known as a city of art and is a world center for street art.
- Melbourne is called “the stencil capital of the world”.
- Inspired by the urban art of New York, Melbourne street artists began painting in the city center in the 1970s.





- Admission to the National Gallery of Victoria is free.
- Aboriginal Art was created with religious and cryptic meanings as part of the spiritual heritage inherited from their ancestors.
- The abstract design is coded with information indicating where food is located, expressing the wisdom of living in nature and a unique worldview.

Aboriginal tradition

- One of the most typical Aboriginal festivals is “Koroborie”.
- This is a festival of spirits, music, and dance, usually held at night, and the most commonly used instrument is the didgeridoo.
- The didgeridoo is a unique Aboriginal instrument, a type of flute made from a 1 to 1.5 meter long eucalyptus tree that has been eaten by white ants.



The Kid Laroi

- He was born Sydney.
- He is a member of the Kamilaroi, an indigenous Australian tribe. And the artist's name "Laroi" comes from the Kamilaroi tribe.
- In 2022, he was nominated for Grammy Award for best new artist.
- He has also won other awards and collaborated with famous artists, making him the man of the hour.
